Pony: if bringing your own pony

- o 2 Water Buckets
- o Hay nets
- o Hay or haylage unless you have paid for hay to be provided
- Straw beds are provided but bring shavings if you want these
- o Grooming Kit.
- Fly spray.
- Bucket, sponge, shampoo (optional) and sweatscraper.
- Saddle and Bridle (in good repair and that fits correctly).
- o Tack must be plain black or brown, no sparkles, cartoon characters etc.
- Numnah must be black, brown, white or navy.
- o Tack cleaning kit.
- o Boots/side reins/daisy reins if required.
- Head collar and spare rope.
- o Fork, broom, shovel and muck bucket or wheelbarrow (ideally share with a friend).
- Chair (for lunch) and camping table if wanted
- Rugs if you need them

Hat (this must confirm to the following standard or you will not ride)

BSI Kitemark, SA1 Global Symbol, Official Snell label with number, The CE symbol alone is not enough. PAS015: 2011 and Snell E2016 meet a higher impact criteria. The SEI hat is not approved. Parents are responsible for the correct fitting and condition of their child's riding hat.

Back protector (BETA approved and correctly fitted). **No air vests** Jodphurs (beige or coloured)

Long sleeved shirt (it is compulsory to have long sleeves to ride)

Riding boots

Riding Gloves.

Pony Club Sweatshirt/baselayer

Waterproof jacket/umbrella

Mucking out clothes to wear over riding clothes.

T-shirt, jeans shorts and trainers (optional for evening wear)

Notebook and Pen

Sunscreen.

Swimming costume/trunks/towel if it is hot. (Clothes ok getting wet)

Wellies

Sufficient warm clothing and bedding for sleeping.

Torch

Snacks and drinks

Alarm clock
